<b>Unauthorised use</b>	All	Access doors to activity locked shut when not in use.	
<b>Safety of course</b>	Participants	Leader to check course and condition of bungees before each session noting corners and knots. To give safety talk before session starts.	
<b>Injury</b>	Participants	Safety talk at start Wearing of safety helmets	
<b>Tangled/trapped</b>	Participants	The bottom of the course is free of bungees so the participant or leader can crawl within this area.	
<b>Slip/trip/falling</b>	Participants	Participants to be helped on exit from the frame. Supervision to stop climbing too high. Course checked by leader before session starts.	
<b>Bungee rope breaking</b>	Participants	Inspection properly before session starts by leader. Carry out monthly inspection of fixings by site.	
<b>Weather/unruly behaviour</b>	Participants	Weather and participants monitored and activity terminated if considered unsafe or participants become unruly.	
<b>Covid 19 restrictions</b>	Participants	Leaders and participants should wear a face covering in accordance with current national guidance, 1 participant at a time, hands sanitised before and after.
