

Karts Rules

1. Agreement to having read and understood these rules must be signed for by the camp leader before commencement of the activity, whom will be liable for the duration of the activity booking.
2. The activity can only be run and supervised by a competent adult. They must have read and understood the risk assessment and rules and ensure they are adhered to at all times.
3. Karts must not be used by anyone aged 15 years and above.
4. The camp leader must ensure that adequate first aid cover is available at the activity.
5. Karts must never be ridden anywhere on the campsite except the track.
6. The activity leader must check the karts and track before the activity commences and monitor throughout the activity.
7. Helmets must be worn by all persons.
8. A safety talk should be given to all activity users before the activity starts.
9. No horse play is allowed.
10. Bystanders are not allowed onto the track (does not include marshals) and must never stand on the tyres.
11. Karts must be locked up while not in use.
12. Uncontrollable speeds and dodgems are not permitted.
13. Pushing only allowed when young riders get stuck and only then by a responsible adult.
14. Only one person per Kart.
15. All Karts must ride round the track in the same direction.
16. When handling or pushing the karts, care must be taken as they are heavy. It is not recommended to be done by adults with back problems.

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
